Rules:

1. Official PGA Tour Money Winnings for 2026 events through the Tour Championship

a) PGA Tour Member earnings at all official events: <https://www.pgatour.com/stats/stat.109.html>

b) non-member PGA Tour event earnings: <https://www.pgatour.com/stats/stat.139.html>

(This will include Monday qualifiers, sponsors exemptions, etc. who do not have PGA Tour membership status.)

These earnings have always counted towards official money.)

note: The Tour Championship holds a purse of \$40,000,000 and will count towards the official money earnings of 2026, and therefore, our pool.

(as it did last year)

- the Fedex Cup Bonus money is still separate from official earnings and will not count in the pool.

2. Maximum earnings per pick kept at \$12,000,000.

3. LIV Tour defection clause:

a) Any pool player drafted who subsequently 'defects' to the LIV Tour will receive the greater of their amassed earnings for 2026 (which will switch to non-member) or the average earnings in that draftee's round from the 2025 final results.

b) Player is still eligible to win a portion of the major pot should they win a major.
